The Episcopal Church
Women Medical Grants are
given to Episcopal Groups or
Institutions that help meet
the medical needs in the
Diocese of Los Angeles. A
total of \$5,000 is available
each year. This amount may
be granted to one or divided
among any number of
organizations.

HOW TO APPLY

Complete the application and send to:

When applying be sure to:

- Complete the application in full
- Attach background information detailing how the funds will be used
- Attach a budget for the project

Application deadline is September 30

Grants are awarded once a year on or about November 1. Within one month of the granting session, applicants will be sent a letter announcing the results.

Restrictions:

- Grants may not be awarded for the same project more than every other year.
- Grants are not awarded for operating expenses
- Any funds granted and not used for the specified purpose will revert back to the Episcopal Church Women, Diocese of Los Angeles unless other arrangements have been agreed upon.

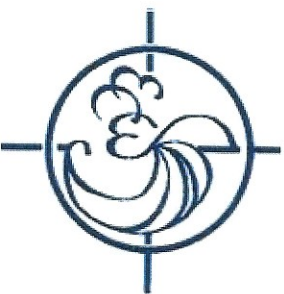
